A. CALL TO ORDER

C. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

D. OLD BUSINESS

- a. **Master Plan-Summer Road Park:** Kevin Koster of VanCleef Engineering presented the master plan for Summer Road Park. A discussion amongst the committee members occurred regarding the plan.
- b. **Capital Project Pickell Park Basketball Court:** Director Bolarakis indicated that the township committee approved the recreation committee's and department's capital request to resurface the basketball court at Pickell Park.
- c. **Tennis Court Maintenance:** Director Bolarakis said that the routine maintenance for the tennis court was completed. This routine maintenance is required to keep the warranty valid.
- d. **Hillcrest Park Rain Garden:** Director Bolarakis said that the rain garden installation was completed. The Open Space Advisory Board received a grant to complete the project.
- e. **Website Update:** Director Bolarakis gave an update to the progress of the new recreation website and registration system.

E. NEW BUSINESS

- a. **COVID-19 Recovery Plan:** Director Bolarakis discussed COVID-19 recovery plan for the department. The plan includes the gradual phase-in of activities based on various risk factors and was based on guidance from the National Recreation and Park Association, New Jersey Recreation and Park Association, CDC guidelines, and state guidelines. The plan was approved by the township committee. Future programming will follow the recovery plan.
- b. **Summer Programs:** A discussion on summer programs was held. The programs the department is holding will follow the recovery plan and CDC and state guidelines for recreation programming.
- c. **Summer Camp Experience at the Park:** Assistant Director VanDongen discussed the camp experience program. He mentioned that this program will look different than in previous years because of the outdoor nature of the camp and the COVID-19 guidelines and restrictions. The camp operating procedures were discussed.
