

**TOWNSHIP OF READINGTON
NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY**

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Readington, in the County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, on June 3, 2024. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Municipal Building, in the Township on June 17, 2024 at 7:45 o'clock p.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of the full bond ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: ***BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A FIRE TRUCK FOR THE WHITEHOUSE FIRE COMPANY IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF READINGTON, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$1,565,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,186,750 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF – Ordinance #20-2024***

Purpose(s): Acquisition of a fire ladder truck for the Whitehouse Fire Company, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$1,186,750

Grants (if any) Appropriated: \$0

Section 20 Costs: \$100,000

Useful Life: 20 years
